Research the uniformed service of your choice. First, locate their official website and find the information listed below, ideally making your own notes as you find each item. Please keep your notes in a safe place, either in a Word file or alternatively in a notebook which can become the start of your new course. If you are most interested in a military career you will be able to access all of the information quite easily, however, this can be a little more problematic for some civilian services (police, fire and rescue service, ambulance service, prison service). If your focus is on a civilian service please find what information you can from the Nottinghamshire emergency service individual websites and you may also choose to search on careers websites (if you do this, please keep a note of which website you found each piece of information from).

Remember to only use UK websites - your course will focus on UK uniformed services only.

What are your service's entry requirements? Find out as much detail as you can about:

Minimum and maximum age upon entry to the service

Are any qualifications required, if so which ones?

What is their selection process? (interview, written tests, physical tests etc)

What is their tattoo and piercings policy?

Are there any requirements for specific nationalities?

What personal characteristics are they looking for in their recruits?

What are the main objectives/priorities of the uniformed service?
